

Who Is Community Care?

REACHING OUT TO YOU

Community Care is a managed care organization that oversees your behavioral health services. Use the services of Community Care when you need information about or want to get care for:

- *A **mental health condition.**
- *An **alcohol problem.**
- *A **drug problem.**

Community Care Offers Information

They answer questions about your health plan and your benefits. They also answer questions about your mental health or drug and alcohol treatment plans. You may ask them about self-help groups in your community.

Referrals: They refer you to health and social services not covered by your health plan. They can also refer you to self-help and support groups.

Treatment: They can help you find treatment for a mental health or drug and alcohol problem and help you make an appointment.

Health Coordination: They help all of your healthcare providers work together to meet your needs.

Care Management: Care Manager's work with you and your residential treatment staff to help you coordinate your treatment for behavioral health care services. A **Care Manager** is a health professional, such as a nurse, social worker, or psychologist, who works for Community Care.
